The following provides traffic signs information to pass your knowledge and/or written test with the Ministry of Transportation. : For additional information call us to (416) 245-2812

Regulatory Signs: These signs give a direction that must be obeyed.



Stop



Do not turn left



No pedestrians allowed on this road



Yield the right-of-way



Do not drive through



Do not pass on this road



Do not stop in the area between the signs



Do not turn to go in the opposite direction (U-turn)



No bicycles allowed on this road



Do no enter this road



Do not turn left during the times shown



Do not park in the area between the signs, except to load or unload passengers or merchandise



Parking space is only for vehicles displaying a valid Disabled Person Parking Permit



Keep to the right of the traffic island



The speed limit in this zone is lower during school hours



Pedestrian crossing or crossover



Speed limit changes ahead



Follow direction according to your lane



Lane is only for two-way left turns



Slow traffic on multi-lane roads must keep right



Travel in way direction only



Area reserved for pick up and drop off of passangers with disabilities



Lane reserved for bicycles



Lane reserced for the specified vehicle during the times shown

Warning Signs: These signs warn of dangerous or unusual conditions.



Narrow bridge ahead



Pavement narrows ahead



Chevron - Guide drivers around sharp curves in the road



Road branching off ahead



Curve in the road ahead



Winding road ahead



Intersection ahead



Maximum safe speed for the road ahead



Bridge ahead lifts or swings to let boats pass



Hidden intersection



Turn in the road ahead



Paved surface ends ahead



Bicycle crossing ahead



Stop signal ahead, slow down



Share the road with oncoming traffic



Pavement is slippery when wet



Hazard close to the edge of the road



The road ahead is split into two separate roads by a median



Traffic lights ahead, slow down



Steep hill ahead



Two roads will join ahead



Snowmobiles cross this road



Underpass ahead, sign shows how much room you have



Bump or uneven pavement on the road ahead



Railway crossing ahead



Sharp turn or bend in the direction of the arrow



Deer cross this road, be alert for animals



Truck entrance on the right side of the road ahead



Shows maximum safe speed on ramp



Watch for pedestrians



Watch for fallen rock



There may be water flowing over the road



School zone, slow down and drive with extra caution



School crossing



School crossing ahead

Temporary conditions signs: These signs warn of unusual temporary conditions such as road work zones, diversions, detours, lane closures or traffic control people on the road.



Construction work ahead



Road work ahead



Survey crew working on the road ahead



Traffic control person ahead. Drive slow



Temporary detour



Flashing lights on the arrows show the direction to follow.



You are entering a construction zone.



Pavement has been milled or grooved.



Closed line.



Lane ahead is closed for road work.



Do not pass the pilot or pace vehicle bearing this sign



Reduce speed and be prepared to stop

Information and direction signs: These signs tell you about distances and destinations.



Shows directions to nearby towns and cities



Distance in kilometers to towns and cities on the road



More than one exit lane



Arrows show which lanes lead off the highway



One or more lanes lead off the highway



The term 'VIA' describes the roads that must be followed to reach a destination



Route to the airport



Route to ferry service

Other signs



You may park in the area between the signs during the times posted



Snowmobiles may use this road



Don't drink and drive



These signs change according to traffic conditions



Shows route to passenger railway station



Shows facilities available such as fuel, food, accomodation or camping



Shows type of fuel available: D - diesel; P - propane; N - natural gas



Slow-moving vehicles
